Page 1 new check box for updated SAR should include the word recurring : Check this box if this is an updated or recurring report.

Also suggest the online report allow for N/A to be typed in subject information boxes. Example :if the bank does not know the phone number of the suspect, alpha characters (N/A) can not be type in this space. So banks leave the space blank and it is then unknown of the entry was forgotten or if the information was not available.

As banks try to include as much information on the narrative section of the SAR, having directions on the same page hinders that process. The natural instinct is to try to only use one page for the narrative. Moving all directions off the narrative page, thus increasing available space would lead to more detailed reporting.
